The Friends of The Summit County Library held their first Used Book Sale in three years. The inmate work crew was a huge help with setup and takedown. FOL made \$3,000 from this sale.

Two new sessions of The Great Decisions will begin soon.

Streaming devices, along with some other nontraditional items are being added to the library collection for patrons to check out. Shaylee Phelps is working on the new Library of Things and there is a new page on the website highlighting these items.

Neal Shusterman's visit was a great success. Approximately 125 people attended.

The author Ruta Sepetys will be visiting this year.

2022...It Could Have Been Worse - Soylent Green Film Screening was shown and followed by a discussion led by staff member Destiny Grose.

Powder Days: Ski Bums, Ski Towns and the Future of Chasing Snow by Heather Hansman is the book chosen for One Book One Community this year. Multiple events are scheduled in partnership with Park City Library, Park City Film Series, and Dolly's

Bookstore and will be held throughout the summer.

Library employee Noa Ackman attended the Guadalajara International Book Fair in November. She was able to purchase many Spanish language items for the Library

system. It is the largest gathering of Spanish-language publishers in the world.

Kamas is currently displaying the State traveling art exhibit titled "Utah Women Making History". It is a relevant exhibit and is being well received.
