## Extended Access Hours (Open+) -

Registered Open+ user numbers have increased. Usage increased in September but decreased in October.

Outdoor Wi-Fi concerns at the Kimball Junction Branch —Deputy Nguyen and Captain Wright said that individuals parking overnight or staying long term have decreased since signs were installed in the Richins Building parking lot.

**2023 Budget Request** – The Budget Committee and County Manager's Recommended Budget for 2023 is out and ready to be reviewed. County Council will vote for approval before the end of the year.

**Kamas & Kimball Junction Lockers** – The Kamas and Kimball Junction book lockers have been installed and are ready for testing for use.

*Friends of the Library* –The annual FOL meeting/election is scheduled for Nov. 15. The Friends raised close to \$5,000 for Live PC Give PC.

*Virtual Author Events* – Virtual author events continue to be successful. There was a recent article about this program in the Park Record.

**Neal Shusterman Author Visit** – Neal Shusterman's visit is on Nov. 29. Staff and the community are preparing and advertising for this event.

*Utah Native Plant Society* – The library's partnership with the Utah Native Plant Society is continuing to progress and grow. Dr. Joseph Wilson spoke about Native Bees of Utah at the last meeting.

*Traveling Art Exhibit at the Kamas Branch* – Kamas is currently displaying the State traveling exhibit titled "Ancient Painters of the Colorado Plateau".

Library Team Day –The Library Team Day was earlier this month. The majority of the library staff attended with Janna Young. The keynote speaker was Rebekah Cummings, University of Utah - Digital Matters Interim Director, Utah State Library Board – Chair. She spoke about censorship and recent efforts of book banning around Utah, with staff brainstorming on how we can be more informed/prepared for challenges.
