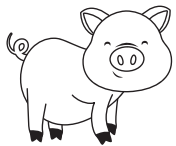
Baby Hop

The teacher did reply.

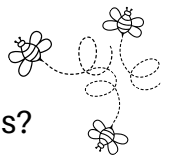
All Around the Barnyard

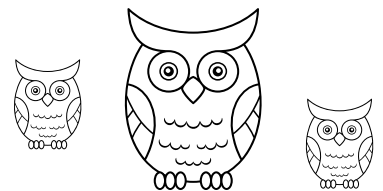
There was a farmer
